



## Deep Green Product

Marin Clean Energy (MCE) provides two unique energy supply options to its customers. The Deep Green product is 100% renewable energy. This option uses renewable resources such as solar, wind, biomass, small hydroelectric facilities under 30 megawatts in size, and other renewable energy products.

MCE's Deep Green rates for Phase I customers, who will begin receiving service from MCE in May 2010, will be an additional \$0.01 per kWh. Phase II customers will not begin to receive service from MCE until the spring or summer of 2011.

Many customers who are part of Phase II have contacted MEA inquiring about their ability to begin service under the 100% renewable energy Deep Green option in advance of the Phase II rollout of the Marin Clean Energy program.

Early Phase II Deep Green Volunteers will pay a cost premium estimated at \$10 per month plus \$0.01 per kWh used. The incremental cost would be higher for customers that use more energy during the month as it would be \$10 plus the amounts shown in the following table:

To determine which phase you are in, you may call 888-632-3674.

Determining what the Deep Green product will cost you is easy! Simply look at your kWh usage located on your PG&E bill and multiply it by \$0.01. This is the additional fee that you will pay for Deep Green.

For example, if you use 500 kWh per month, the extra cost would be \$5 per month.
